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


Proforma created to identify Slow Performers/ Advanced Learners

Identification of slow learners

As the student enter a new academic session, after three month first assessment of the entire batch is done via theoretical written exam (MCQs and written theory paper) and clinical assessment exam. The student who are found to show minimum scores were categorized to be **Slow learners/ achievers**. The slow learners after their identification are periodically given special classes (remedial classes) so that their performance can be boosted. Simultaneously personnel counselling is given to such students by their mentors to understand their reason for weakness and give them emotion and personnel support.

Identification of advance learners

Advanced learners/ achievers are also identified by the same mechanism of exam and those who are found to achieve above 90 percent were considered to be advanced learners. Such students are motivated by their respective mentors to use their creative and innovative skills in learning process.

2.2.1 Mechanism to Identify advanced learners and slow learners

At the start of the academic year in September of each year, the university college has an orientation program for all new UG and PG lots. The program helps students become familiar with the institution, the course program and extracurricular activities, facilities, rules and regulations of the institution. • At the beginning of the batch session, a wide variety of assessment components will continue, including internal assessment exams including theoretical knowledge and assessment of practical skills in clinical assignments in individual departments, from homework to home, classroom homework, seminars and discussions, a quiz based and viva voce. These allow an effective assessment of the learning levels of different students. . After the initial assessment, both underperforming and advanced students are identified and based on this alternative schedule, the faculty is compiled. Corrective courses are held for underachieving/slow learners in the relevant departments, followed by improvement exams for the respective students. Likewise for advanced learners, exercises as needed, advanced learners are encouraged to participate in various learning activities to further develop their skills. • In addition, teacher-student interactions, the results of assessment protocols, and relevant committee meetings help identify different levels of learners. Academic progress is reviewed by affected faculty members and therefore advises student

Identification of slow learners

When the student enters a new academic session, a first evaluation of the whole is carried out after three months via a written theoretical exam (MCQ and written theoretical article) and a clinical evaluation study. Students with minimal scores were categorized as slow students/students. Slow learners are periodically given special lessons (remedial classes) after identification so that their performance can be improved. At the same time, these students receive personal advice from their mentors to understand the reason for their weakness and provide them with emotional and personal support. Identification of advance learners

Advanced/successful learners are also identified by the same assessment mechanism and those scoring above 90 percent were considered advanced learners. These students are motivated by their respective mentors to use their creative and innovative skills in the learning process.

Details Of Outcome Measures

The effect of the range of activities undertaken to improve the skills of slow learners and advanced learners must be calculated to see both positive and/or converse consequences, requiring active participation. interests of students as well as facilitators so that both groups of students benefit . • Students are assessed after the first and second internal assessment, the results are kept completely transparent to the students, reports are sent to parents upon request. • A group of students is assigned to a faculty member as a mentor on the student's personal and academic achievement.

To ensure, following measures are taken:

SLOW LEARNERS:

The analysis is performed based on an initial theoretical and clinical internal evaluation and those with poor performance are identified as poor performers. •

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The departments organize remedial courses, give lectures, are repeated if necessary, depending on their performance in follow-up exams / remedial exams.

A group of slow learners is assigned to a counseling faculty, counselors monitor academic performance and communicate regularly to understand how to help these students.

- Mentors communicate with students and parents about the results of remedial exams.
- Encourage and create a stimulating environment for slow learners and communicate with them to increase understanding of their problems to improve their pace and performance on the university exam.
 Faculty members review the most difficult topics and clinical practices according to student demand and receive assistance.
- Detailed academic activities are planned throughout the year to improve their performance on the university exam.

ADVANCED LEARNERS:

Highest-performing students are similarly identified through assessment exams and based on their active involvement in class discussions and practicals.

- Students are invited and encouraged to participate in group discussions, competitive quizzes to develop their presentation skills and skills in exams and clinics, participate in research projects to teach the focus of the research, write articles, etc.
- Diligent and brilliant students are motivated and inspired to reach academic ranks, have the opportunity to develop their creativity by organizing and participating in peer symposia and workshops, as well as at the national level, depending on their interest.
- Students are encouraged and prepared to take competitive exams, for postgraduate courses and others.
- Top graders and university grade holders are encouraged with certificates and awards by the institutioConsolidated report regarding welfare on

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special programs for advanced learners and slow learners

Consolidated reports is based on the records of student progress and observation and time table schedules which is sent to the governing body for academic administration. The entire curriculum, the method of teaching and evaluation, and the design for extra-curricular activities, seminars, workshops, conferences, training programs, etc. are sent for review by Dean academics.

They evaluate the roll-out and approval or otherwise of these academic

programmes.

The faculty and experts put together the Course Structures, the detailed syllabus and objectives for all the sessions to be taken for both sets of students, which is then reviewed by The Dean Academic affairs.

The proposed revision to the Academic Council as and when required is

done, and notified the students accordingly.

Course based student feedback is collected on teaching and learning and is conveyed to the respective faculty members so that they incorporatechanges and contribute to teaching learning process.

Methodology for assessment of Slow Learner

A slow learner (Weak Students) means those who could not keep pace with the classroom teaching needs extra attention so as to bring such students at par with the rest of the students of the class.

Slow learners are identified based on their performance in University Examination of previous semester and internal examinations.

Measures taken for improving academic performance of these students are:-

- (i) Remedial/Extra classes are conducted with appropriate focus on the subject/topic codes in which the students are found to be slow learners.
- (ii) Regular assignments of the topics in which the student is found to be weak.
- (iii) Teacher guardian is provided to each student so that he/she may contact the teacher for any queries whether academic or personal.
- (iv) Tests and quiz are taken of weak students.
- (v) Notes and desired study material is provided to them for their easy understanding of the subject they are weak in.

Methodology for assessment of Advance Learner

- Advanced Learners (bright students) are those students who are ahead on the learning curve and require advanced technical know-how.
- Advanced earners are identified based on the performance in University Examination of previous semester and internal examinations.
- Following Special activities are conducted for Advanced Learners:
 - i) Guiding for career planning.
 - Discussion or seminar on the advanced topic
 - Guiding and encouraging to communicate research papers in conferences/Journals
 - iv) Guiding the students for GATE/Competitive Examinations.
 - v) Training programs for gaining advanced technical know-how.


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vi) Encouraging to participate in various symposiums like quiz, poster presentation,
 Conferences, inter institution competition etc.

The teaching, learning and assessment strategies are diversified, dedicated and student oriented to get the best out of the inputs through professional teaching, practical experimentations, field visits, creative involvement through interdisciplinary activities, and promotion of intelligent endeavors and facilitation of the research, training and capacity building through the established networks of scientists, researchers and facilitators in the University.

The University through its constituent units is sustaining the improvement drive every year for teaching, learning and evaluation by implementing the detailed recommendations by IQAC Committees at each Institute. These recommendations are the result of an elaborate process of feedback, discussions, orientation and opinion making by the subject experts. In addition, emphasis is also given to identify low achievers and the ways for their improvement which includes the special attention to low achievers by arranging separate classes for them. The detailed plan of action in this regard ensures the improvement and confidence of performance among these students.

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SOP of Advanced Learner

Within the classrooms faculty have to deal with different types of students; some are very intelligent who learn very fast and some are quite weak who learn very slowly. Therefore it is required to determine the abilities of the students in the class. Based on the ability determined, some students need only guidance and some students need a hard work and regular attention. Generally on the basis of their learning speed students can be classified in two groups; advanced learners and slow learners. Each type of students has different learning attitudes and learning habits. A faculty has to adapt a teaching methodology such that he/she may not lose the attention of the slow learners and bore the advanced learners.

It shall be done based on one or more of the following;

- a) Analysis of mid sem. marks
- b) Communication and soft skills
- c) Their behavioral traits
- d) Theory and Practical performance
- e) Performance in mid sem. test/ final term exam etc.

Advanced Learner:

The advanced learner students who learn fast are called advanced learners. Obviously their learning speed is more than the peers.

One or more of the following options shall be used;

- 1. Encourage them to work with slow learners in practical hours
- 2. Splitting of class for group activities
- 3. Mapping of students for extra-curricular and co-curricular activities
- 4. Quiz competitions
- 5. Insisting to complete NPTEL/ GATE Open Course

6. Group activity leader for assignment/Project task

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SOP of Slow Learner

A "slow learner" is not a diagnostic category, it is a term people use to describe a student who has the ability to learn necessary academic skills, but at rate and depth below average same age peers. In order to grasp new concepts, a slow learner needs more time, more repetition, and often more resources from teachers to be successful. Reasoning skills are typically delayed, which makes new concepts difficult to learn.

A slow learner has difficulty with higher order thinking or reasoning skills. This suggests that it will be more challenging to learn new concepts. New skills need to be based upon already mastered concepts. This can be difficult when the majority of the class has already mastered a concept and is moving on, while the slow learner needs more time. This can lead to gaps in knowledge and basic skills. The more gaps in a content area, the more challenging it is for anyone to learn new concepts. It's also important to recognize that these students are typically keenly aware they are struggling and self confidence can be an issue.

The slow learners are the students who have slow speed then other students. They need patience and a regular monitoring.

One or more of the following options shall be used:

- 1. Be humble and patient with slow learners
- 2. Encourage parent-teacher meet of such students
- 3. Motivate them
- 4. Create a healthy and conducive environment for slow learners to improve their pace
- 5. Arrange extra remedial Classes
- 6. Arrange extra Lecture
- 7. Mentoring such students



POLICY FOR SLOW LEARNERS & ADVANCED LEARNERS

SLOW LEARNERS is a term used to describe the academic ability of a student of below average intelligence, whose thinking skills have developed significantly more slowly than the norm for his/her age. In order to grasp the new concept a low performer needs more time, more repetition & often more attention from faculty.

The analysis is done on the basis of first internal assessment of theory & practical/clinical and those whose performance is poor are identified under low performers. (The lowest scores of the class are generally considered).

REMEDIAL MEASURES FOR SLOW LEARNERS:

Individualization of academic guidance should be adapted to teach low performer students according to the needs of their particular type of mental ability. Use of appropriate methods of learning should be included in the dynamic integrated process:-

- Providing Motivation by a good teacher- pupil relationship. This is facilitated by DES (Dynamic Evaluation System) and Mentor Mentee system.
- ii) Consolidation- Frequent repetition, adequate revisions are done for better consolidation of the learned material. Extra classes, simplified language, repetitive emphasis on certain important concepts are promoted.
- iii) Continuous evaluation, through MCQs and viva voce & its cumulative record to be kept over their academic session period to monitor the progress.
- iv) Parent Education & Guidance on how to promote development of their ward at home would be of great assistance.

ADVANCED LEARNERS

Advanced learner is someone who is successful in their studies & work, usually as a result of their efforts. They tend to be well organized, with good time-management skills, &score high marks and good grades. They have a strong desire to accomplish something meaningful.

Having succeeded at the routine curricular work, such individuals show an inclination to achieve more credentials academically and scientifically. Such students are encouraged to attend conferences, present papers and posters and do research.
