

1. Some teachers were not found punctual which causes delays in further periods, lunch timings as well as college closing time.
2. This year it was found that some students were from Hindi medium those are unable to interact or hesitate to the teachers, who are very fluent in English. After this analysis chairperson decided to call the meeting in which all the teachers are going requested to communicate in Hindi as well during classes and practical time with slow learners.
3. Some of the teachers are requested to hand over their cell phone to their colleagues at the time of their classes so that teachers are accessible in the department through the concerned person when they don't have their cell phones with them during classes.
4. It was suggested that Video should be included for the understanding of topic by the teachers during classes through smart classes.
5. It was also found that some of teachers are not regularly in touch with parents so committee has suggested to the principal to organize one meeting once in a semester with all teachers who are Teacher Guardian (T.G.) to check and verify their Mentor Mentee files.

According to feedbacks some discussion was taken by the committee:

1. **According to student's feedback** about teaching it was noticed that some teachers were still not found punctual and regular in classes (Offline / Online) for which Principal strictly instructed the teachers for punctuality and regularity and feedback committee was instructed by chairperson to monitor the punctuality and regularity of all teachers randomly and report to Principal.
2. **According to Student Satisfactory Survey it was noticed that**
 - Maximum responses received was from Bachelor of Pharmacy students. Committee suggested to encourage the P.G. and Ph.D. students through their class teachers and Mentors for the participation in feedback survey.
 - Below 50% students agreed about syllabus coverage in the class was between 85 to 100% which should be improved for which committee and chairperson suggested the teachers to verify the course completion and revision from students at the end of the session.
 - As in this session, maximum classes were taken online which increased the usage of ICT tools during lectures through teachers which was found helpful in clearing concepts and better understanding. But some students also faced issues of connectivity during this academic session which was sorted out through Mock trial of classes.
 - Below 50% students agreed about thoroughly preparation and proper communication for the classes by teachers which was observed due to instant change in the way of classes taken by the teachers i.e. online which makes uncomfortable to both teachers and students. For which committee suggested some points to teachers and asked the teachers to convey the same to students i.e **(1) Optimize internet and don't panic when get disconnected. (2) Be aware of what others can see and hear. (3) Learn and teach how to Minimize distractions and Plan ahead.**
 - Some complaints received about non-functioning of some instruments during practicals i.e. hindering the knowledge gain during offline classes which was discussed with Principal and was found already sorted just after reopening of institute.
3. **According to Parents Feedback** some parents were not satisfied and complaints regarding non communication from mentors and institute which was discussed with all teaching and non-teaching staff to regularly communicate with Parents and guardians and update their Mentor Mentee file.
4. Some important suggestions received from alumni for library facilities in which they suggested to increase the number of Reference Books in Library and also start the issuance of those

reference books to students at least for 2days for the better preparation of notes. But the committee and librarian suggested that as the Saturday's second half is free for some students that may utilized the same time for the preparation of notes. So, the suggestion of issuance of those reference books to students was declined by the committee and librarian

5. Previous suggestion from alumni and students for computer lab upgradation was found under process and 20 more Personal computers are in proposal for installation.
6. *According to the Faculty feedback* the internet facility in the institute should be upgraded and the syllabus for upcoming freshers of 1st semester should be considered for revision as it was found tough for freshers of Bachelor of Pharmacy.
