

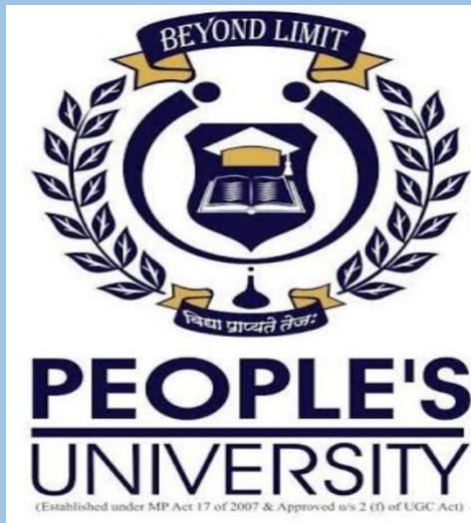

The decisions taken in the meeting were welcomed by all the members.








- Fifth meeting was held on 20 /08/2022, members had discussion on the efficacy of Class presentations and Group discussions in slow learner support.

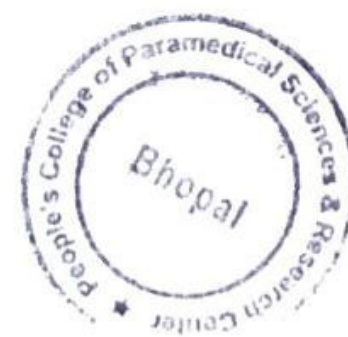
