Faculty Feedback on Curriculum

Feedback Summary - Questionnaire no. 1 Session 2017-18

Feedback on the basis of Questionnaire no. 1 was randomly taken.

Parameters Evaluated – Students feedback on Curriculum.

Feedback was obtained from the students at the end of Academic session.

Most of the students believe that depth of course content and extent of its coverage was satisfactory and only 20% students feel it to be unsatisfactory. More than 60% Students opted good as a response to applicability and relevance of course to real life situation.

50 % Students concluded that the course was concentually manageable.58% Students agreed that library material for the course was adequate. Overall rating by students was found to be satisfactory to good.

Feedback Summary - Questionnaire no. 3 Session- 2017-18

Feedback on the basis of Questionnaire no. 3 was randomly taken.

Parameters Evaluated - Feedback of Students overall evaluation on programme and teaching

Feedback was collected from students after the final results were declared.

Most of the students agreed that the curriculum was adequate and easy to understand.

It was also inferred that 85 to 100% of syllabus was covered in class and the library study material was found to be adequate. Maximum number of Students Agreed that teachers thoroughly prepared for the classes and were effectively able to communicate.

For encouraging students participation in class, in class discussions were conducted.45% of students stated that to some extent there were opportunities to interact with the teachers and small group works were promoted. Most of the students said that regular assignments were assigned, discussed and evaluated by the concerned staff.

Feedback Summary - Questionnaire no. 4

Session - 2017-18

Feedback on the basis of Questionnaire no. 4 was randomly taken.

Parameters Evaluated: Feedback of Student's evaluation of the programme of study.

Feedback was collected after final results were declared.

Maximum number of students said that before undertaking the programme they got the prospectus which had all the details of Fee structure and refunds, courses and admission rules, counseling and health services.50% of students said that their particular interest in subject and past scores in the subject determined the choice of subjects. Maximum Students stated that choice of courses offered was good and it had practical work. It was concluded that laboratories and workshops were adequately equipped and maintained. More than 60% of class said that they were provided training for library usage and the prescribed readings of their subjects were easily available and accessible. Computer training was provided to students and E-library facility is also available.

Students partly agreed that internal evaluation system is desirable while according to some it need changes. 80% of students stated that internal assessment was done and properly evaluated. Departments had provision for grievances. Teachers can encourage maximum participation of students in class through discussions.

At the end of programme, Maximum students said that they came out better informed and skilled while some students showed enthusiasm to pursue further studies.

The student teacher relationship was rated satisfactory in department.32% of students said that there's need to improve hostel facilities . health care facilities were found to be good. Teachers showed a co-operative attitude towards extra-curricular activities.

More than 60% students said that they would proudly talk about the institution after graduating.

Feedback Summary – Faculty Feedback Form Session - 2017-18

Parameters Evaluated: Faculty feedback on curriculum design and development.

Feedback was collected randomly from the staff members of all the department.

Faculty feedback was found satisfactory in most of the aspects. 50% of faculties strongly agreed that board of studies is taking care of the currency and relevance of the courses offered. More than 60% of faculties agreed that employability and skill development were given equivalent weightage in curriculum deisgn and development.40% of staff members responded neutrally to updation of curriculum from time to time. 33% of staff members responded that they were given enough freedom to contribute and implement their ideas on curriculum design and development.

Suggestions from faculties for improvement of curriculum design and development included upgradation of curriculum from time to time, providing incentives, incorporation of advanced teaching methods.
