

The session included demonstrations of key instruments such as High-Performance Liquid Chromatography (HPLC), Nuclear Magnetic Resonance (NMR), X-ray Diffraction (XRD), and Transmission Electron Microscopy (TEM). These demonstrations helped students understand these technologies working principles, applications, and significance in scientific research. The visit provided an excellent opportunity to bridge theoretical concepts with practical applications, fostering a deeper interest in analytical methodologies. This experience enhanced student's exposure to cutting-edge scientific tools and modern laboratory techniques. 
