Tuberculosis

- Caused by bacteria *Mycobacterium TB* (*M.Tb*)
- 80% of the TB cases suffer from Pulmonary TB (Lungs) and 20% are extra-pulmonary TB (Outside Lungs)
- Spreads by 'Airborne transmission' and source of infection is sputum positive pulmonary TB case
- Cough (more than 2 weeks), fever, weight loss, chest pain, blood in sputum, fatigue, swelling
