





- 1. "Tell me a little about yourself."
Education, Skills, The goal of an interview is to determine the skills and attitude required for that job.
- 2. "What are your biggest weaknesses?"
Handle it by minimizing your weaknesses and emphasizing your strengths
- 3. "What are your biggest strengths?"
Identify five strengths you feel are most in line with the position for which you're interviewing (e.g., self-motivated, good listener, strong work ethic.) Be clear and precise.
- 4. Why should we hire you?
Summarize your skills and education. I'm confident, I would be a great addition to your team.
- 5. "Why do you want this job?"
Don't just talk about why the company would be great to work for; talk about how the position is a perfect fit for what you hope to accomplish, both short-term and long-term.

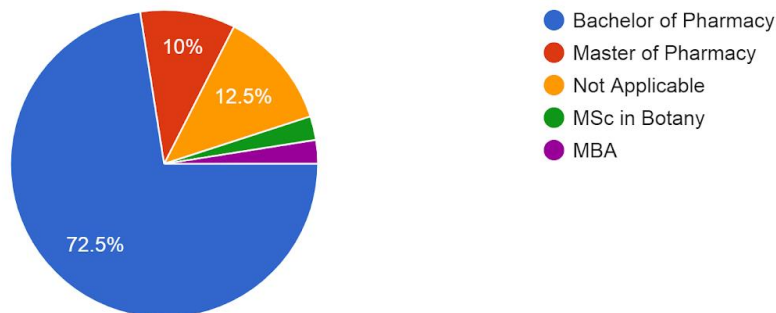

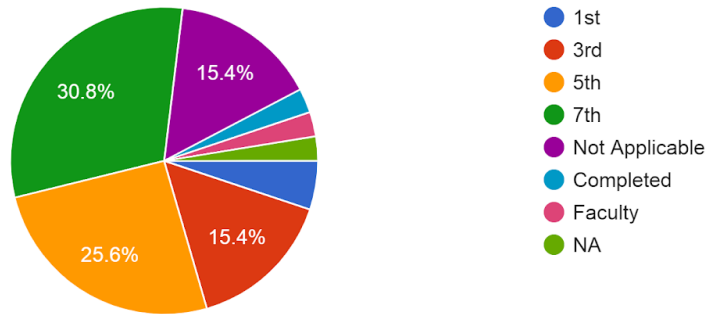

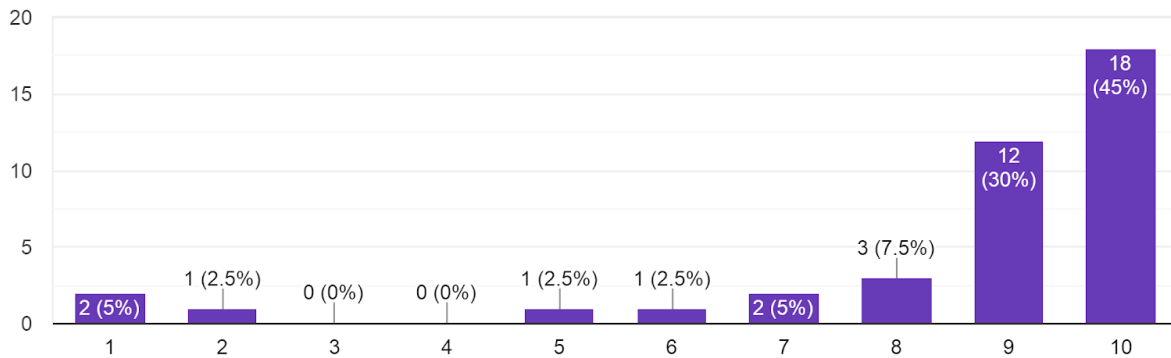

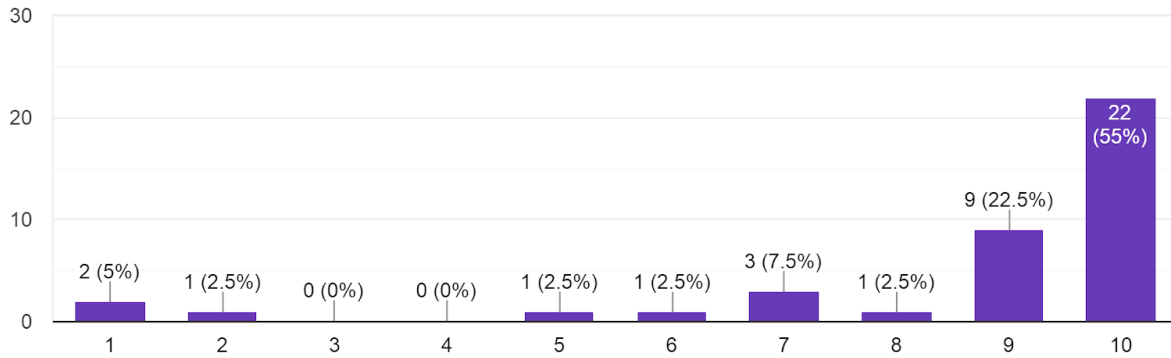

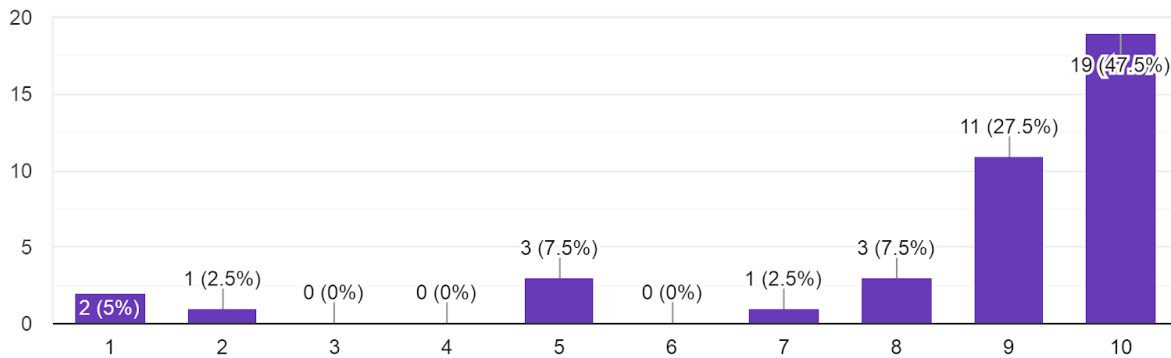

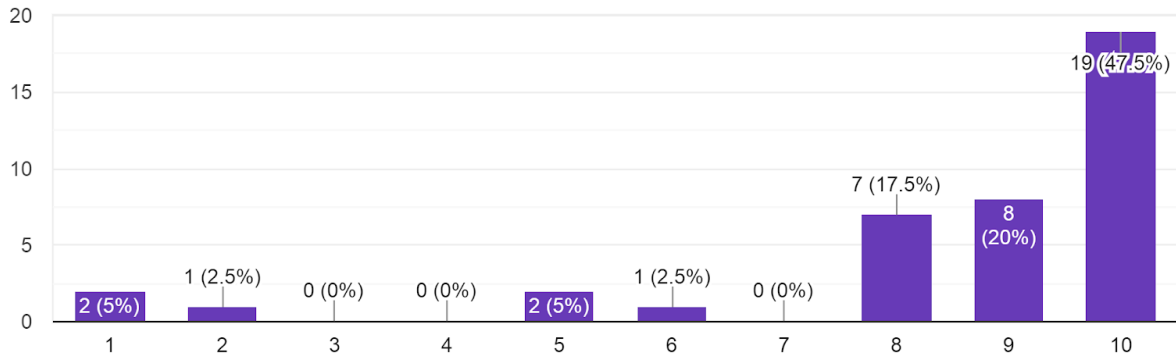

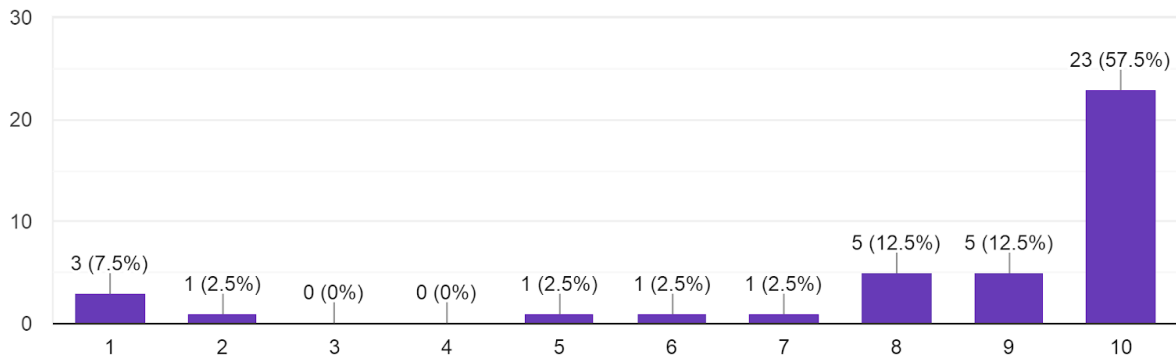

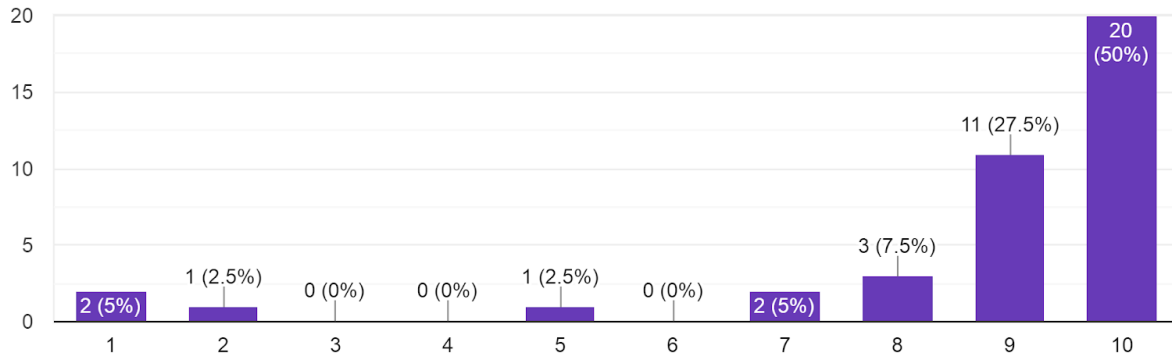
