Sub: Recognition to People's University, Bhopal, Madhya Pradesh as per Section 7(1)(i) of the Advocates Act, 1961 for the purpose of conferring the Degrees in Law and fresh approval to its People's Institute of Legal Studies, People's University, Bhopal, Madhya Pradesh for imparting three year LL.B course and five year BA LL.B course with intake of one section of 60 students in each section in each course for a period of two years i.e. for the academic years 2024-2025 and 2025-2026.

Sir/Ma'am,

This is to bring to your kind knowledge that the Standing Committee of Legal Education Committee of Bar Council of India by virtue of its meeting held on 6th May, 2024 considered the matter of People's Institute of Legal Studies, People's University, Bhopal, Madhya Pradesh.

The Standing Committee considered the inspection report of People's University, Bhopal, Madhya Pradesh. After consideration, Committee found that at present out of 4 courses college is in a position to run only two courses in lieu of shortage of faculty members.

In view of the above, recognition has been granted to People's University, Bhopal, Madhya Pradesh as per Section 7(1)(i) of the Advocates Act, 1961 for the purpose of conferring the Degrees in Law and also fresh approval has been granted to its People's Institute of Legal Studies, People's University, Bhopal, Madhya Pradesh for imparting three year LL.B course and five year BA LL.B course with intake of one section of 60 students in each section in each course for a period of two years i.e. for the academic years 2024-2025 and 2025-2026.

College is directed to appoint 6 more law teachers, 1 history teacher within a period of one year who shall be paid UGC scale for running three year LL.B course and five year BA LL.B course.
