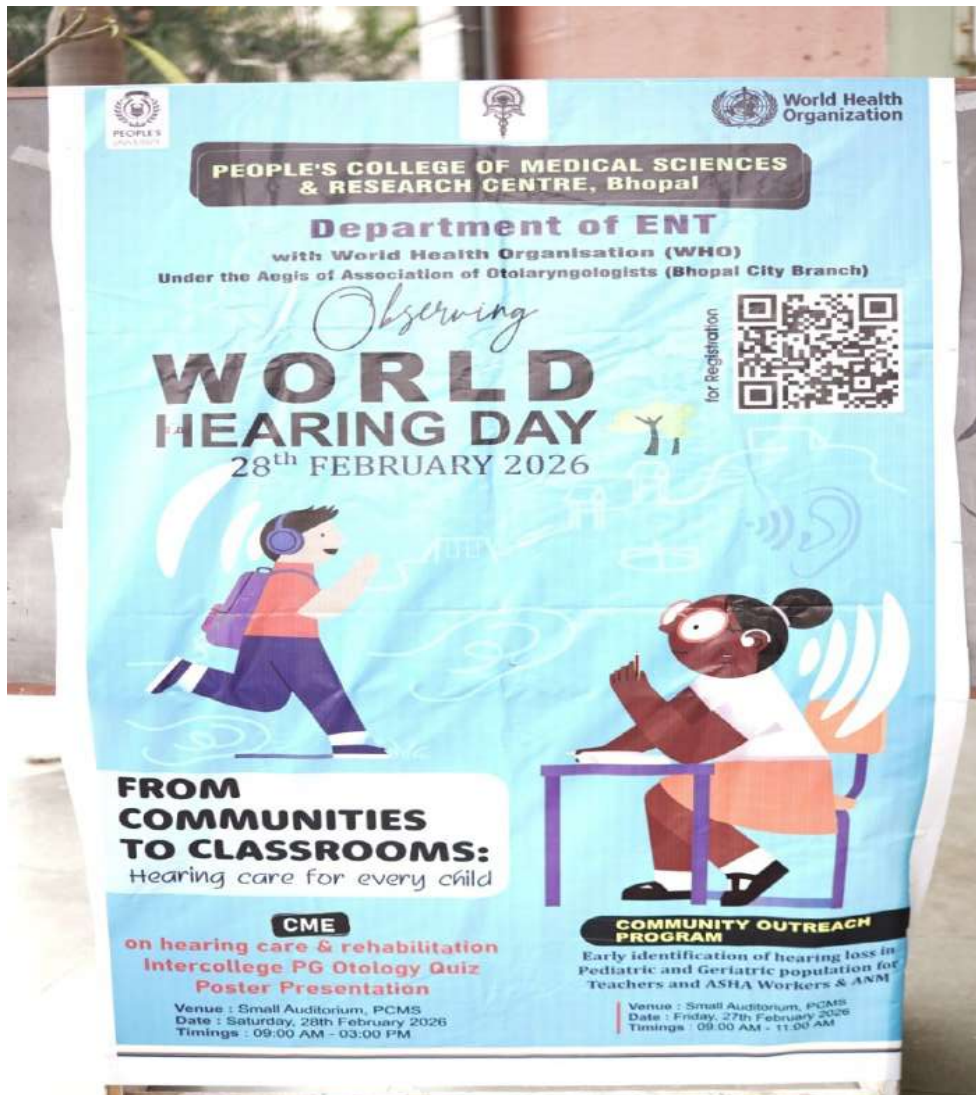
## Academic Engagement & Competitions
